The purpose of the California Craft Spirits Competition (CCSC) is to help promote the craft distillers that are producing the finest quality artisan spirits inside and outside of California and to give participating distillers valuable feedback on the quality and process of their spirits. GENERAL RULES

1. Open to commercially licensed spirits producers in California with valid DSP permit and/or distributors. All spirits must be entered with permission of the brand owners. All spirits must conform to federal TTB and state ABC regulations and standards of identity and be currently produced in commercial quantities.
2. The competition also offers a separate division with all the same rules, regulations and schedule to producers outside of California. Entrants must designate California or outside California (Invitational) at time of registration. This Invitational will have a separate set of awards from the California division.
3. All entries must be submitted with a current APPROVED COLA registration. Categories that are not recognized by the TTB or not in approved TTB size formats will be automatically removed from the competition.
4. Each entry to consist of (2) 750ml or (2) 375ml of each spirit to be entered.
5. Do not ship the spirits without copies of the necessary COLAs from TTB.
DSP- Distilled Spirits Plants
COLA- Certificate of Label Approval
6. All entries must be registered through the official online registration: <http://cmsfs.fairmanager.com> and must reach the Fair office on or before the entry closing.
7. After an entry is submitted, the entry fee will not be refunded.
8. The judge's decision is final and determines all awards.
9. The same spirit (although marketed under different labels) may not be entered in more than one category. However, a distillery may submit multiple entries in the same category.
10. Classes may be consolidated or divided if entries warrant. Spirits will be judged in the division/class in which they were entered. The coordinator may transfer an entry if it is determined to be more appropriate in another class.
11. Any spirit delivered by mail, freight, or express must be prepaid. No entry will be accepted for which carrier charges have not been prepaid. All entries become the property of the competition.
12. The CCSC, management and staff are not responsible for errors in entries. No producer shall be entitled to an award for which has been disallowed on the basis of the producer's error.
13. Distilleries/ Entries found in violation of rules or ethical practices will forfeit awards and other privileges deemed appropriate by the California Craft Spirits Competition Management and the Chief Judge.
14. Spirits entered must be available for commercial sale.
15. **Please identify in large legible letters, the name of the distillery on the outside of each case. The outside of each case is also to be labeled CCSC. No spirits will be accepted for which carrier charges have not been prepaid. Attach Packing List to outside of case highlighting specific entries inside.**
16. This competition will adhere to the State Rules of the California Department of Food & Agriculture Fairs & Expositions Branch. [State Rules for California Fairs](#)

Distilleries that participate in the California Craft Spirits Competitions are eligible to be part of Get Crafty. Sign up now during registration to participate in the annual Get Crafty Mixology Contest and Tasting, at the California Mid-State Fair. Mixologist, restaurants and/or bars will partner with a participating spirit to create the cocktail of their choice. These creative cocktails will then be featured in the two-hour tasting. There is NO entry fee for the entry into Get Crafty.

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MEDALS (AWARDS)

The judges for the wine competition will be those of the spirits competition. The Judges shall award all medals. Spirits will be considered for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in their respective classes as well as “Best of Class” and “Best of Show.” “Best of Class” awards will be awarded to one spirit from among the gold medal winners in each class to spirits of exceptional merit. The decisions set forth by the Judges will be final.
